SIXTH NATIONAL CONGRESS OF COLLEGE STUDENTS
AND SECOND CAMPUS ADVISERS SEMINAR

To: Bureau Directors
Regional Directors
Schools Superintendents
Presidents, State Colleges and Universities
Heads of Private Schools, Colleges and Universities

1. In line with the government's emphasis on youth involvement in nation-building, the Sixth National Congress of College Students will be held on December 19-23, 1980, in the Senior Mess of Teachers Camp, Baguio City, under the auspices of the YMCA of Manila and the Ministry of Education and Culture.

2. The Second Campus Advisers Seminar will be held simultaneously with the Congress on December 19-23, 1980 at Teachers Camp in Baguio City.

3. The theme of the Congress is "Youth Welfare in the '80s" with the following as sub-topics:

- a. "The Role of Traditional Social Institutions: Family, School, and Church in the Development of the Youth"
- b. "The Role of the Government in Youth Welfare"
- c. "Environmental Influence on Youth Development"

4. The theme of the Advisers Seminar is "The Faculty and Youth Development" with the following as sub-topics:

- a. "The Psycho-Dynamics of Leadership"
- b. "The Process of Controlled Communication"

5. The Congress intends to attain the following objectives:

- a. To understand the development of human resources and enhancement of human environment as a basis for national development;
- b. To appreciate the role of institutions and government in development;
- c. To provide opportunities for actual participation in national development activities.

6. The Congress is open to college students taking degree courses, preferably those with experience in youth leadership training projects/activities. A student delegate shall be at least a second year college student and should be recommended by a school, college, or university head. The Advisers Seminar is open to faculty members involved in campus organization activities/projects.

7. All schools, colleges, and universities are urged to participate in the Congress and in the Advisers Seminar. Heads of schools, colleges, and universities are authorized to recommend not more than ten (10) selected students from each institution to attend the Congress and not more than two (2) for the Advisers Seminar. Deadline for the submission of applications of student-delegates and for advisers is November 15 for provincial delegates and December 10 for Metro Manila delegates. Inclosed are copies of the application forms for the Congress and for the Advisers Seminar.

8. Congress and advisers fees and expenses for accommodations, transportation, and other items that may be incurred in connection with attendance thereto shall be borne by the school, college, or university represented therein or by any private organization.

9. A certificate of attendance signed by the Minister, Deputy Minister of Education and Culture and the President of the YMCA of Manila will be given to each participant. Time spent by Congress participants for actual civic action work while attending the Congress shall be credited as partial fulfillment of YCAP requirements, subject to the provisions of Department Order No. 18, s. 1977, entitled "Guidelines on the Implementation of the Youth Civic Action Program."

10. Student-delegates shall submit reports on their participation in the Congress which shall include a summary of the discussions taken up, prescribed materials and hand-outs, as well as their recommendations.
