PHILIPPINE MILITARY ACADEMY ENTRANCE EXAMINATION

To: Bureau Directors
Regional Directors
Schools Superintendents
Presidents, State Colleges and Universities

1. This Ministry has taken cognizance of the forthcoming entrance examination for cadetship which will be administered by the Philippine Military Academy on October 19, in thirty-three (33) examination centers all over the country. This activity is of utmost importance to interested and qualified young men who may want to avail of a government scholarship leading to a Bachelor of Science degree and a commission as a Second Lieutenant in the Regular Force, Armed Forces of the Philippines. It is therefore highly desirable and necessary that maximum dissemination of this information be given through your principals, head teachers, guidance counsellors, and classroom teachers of high school senior students, and through your registrars and college professors.

2. Applicants must possess the following qualifications:

- a. At least a high school graduate on entry in the PMA on April 1, 1981;
- b. Natural-born, male Filipino citizen;
- c. Single and has never been married;
- d. At least 162.5 cm (5 ft 4 in) tall;
- e. Between 17 and 22 years of age on April 1, 1981;
- f. Of good moral character.

3. Applicants may secure application forms from: Registrar, PMA, Ft. Del Pilar, Baguio City; PMA Liaison Office, Camp General Emilio Aguinaldo, Q.C., PC Provincial and Regional Commands; Civil Relations Service Offices; CMT Commandants; College Registrars and High School Principals. Accomplished application forms shall be mailed directly to: The Registrar, PMA, Ft. Del Pilar, Baguio City. Deadline for submission of application forms is 15 September 80.

4. Qualified applicants will be notified by mail and/or via the national media. The written examination covers English grammar, composition, and literature; high school algebra and plane geometry; and special PMA aptitude test. Successful examinees will be notified and will be directed to report to the PMA Candidate Control and Liaison Team at the AFP Medical Center (formerly V. Luna General Hospital) in Quezon City for medical and physical examinations.
