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NINTH DEVELOPMENT PROGRAM FOR SCHOOLS DISTRICT SUPERVISORS

- 1. The ninth development program for schools district supervisors, under the auspices of the Civil Service Commission and the Ministry of Education and Culture, will be held at Teachers Camp, Baguio City, from October 10 to November 8, 1980. The program content is given in Inclosure No. 1 to this Memorandum.
- 2. Also inclosed is a list of participants to the ninth program for schools district supervisors. Any change in the list should be communicated to this Office, attention: Assistant Secretary for Personnel Management and Development, through the Regional Director.
- 3. Each participant will be required to pay \$250 for training fee and materials. The training fee, transportation expenses to and from the official station, and the daily allowance of \$10 participants are entitled to, should be charged against local funds, subject to the usual accounting and auditing regulations. Accommodations and mess for the duration of the program will be paid by the Ministry of Education and Culture.
- 4. Participants are required to submit a health certificate (General Form 86) duly signed by a government physician and certified by their respective: superintendents attesting to their being physically fit to undertake the training program. It is important that participants should be in excellent health and should have no history of hypertension, cardiac or other serious ailment considering the requirement of the program in Baguio City.

5. Participants should bring with them necessary information about their districts, such as: profile of the district including statistics on population of the area, number of schools, school buildings, etc., list of opening school projects description of supervisors. of on-going school projects, description of supervisory practices and educational trends, etc. which may be utilized for exercises in planning or project development.

It is desired that the contents of this Memorandum be immediately brought to the attention of those concerned.
