ORIENTATION ON THE TRYOUT OF INSTRUCTIONAL
MATERIALS ON WATER CONSERVATION

To: Bureau Directors
Regional Directors
Schools Superintendents
Presidents, State Colleges and Universities
Heads of Private Schools, Colleges and Universities

1. The curriculum materials developed for the joint MEC-Local Water Utilities Administrations (LWUA) Project: WATER (Water Awareness Through Educational Resource) will be tried out this school year starting in November.

2. In this connection, an orientation conference for all regional and division staffs and teachers (elementary level only) involved in the tryout will be held in all regions starting from October 13 to 31, 1980. The orientation will be conducted by two teams, A and B, composed of representatives from MEC and LWUA.

3. For this purpose, it is requested that regional offices make the necessary arrangements for the following:

- a. Selection of 3 pilot elementary schools: one private, one public urban, and one public rural nearest the regional office as tryout schools.
- b. Immediate notification of the staff and the tryout teachers relative to their involvement and their attendance at the orientation conference. In this regard, tryout teachers per pilot class or grade level shall be composed of classroom teachers from kindergarten to Grade IV, and teachers actually teaching Social Studies, Science, Filipino, and Mathematics in Grades V and VI.

4. A local water district representative will coordinate with the regional office regarding the venue of the orientation conference. The cost of the food (2 snacks and 1 lunch) for the participants shall be borne by the LWUA.

5. Inclosed are the schedule of conference by region, the participants, and the tentative program of activities.
