19th NATIONAL RIZAL YOUTH LEADERSHIP INSTITUTE

1. The Order of the Knights of Rizal, in collaboration with the Ministry of Education and Culture, will hold the 19th National Rizal Youth Leadership Institute on December 26-30, 1980 at the Roxas Hall, Junior Mess, Teachers Camp, Baguio City in commenoration of the 84th Death Anniversary of Dr. Jose Rizal. The over-all theme will be "Rizal and Mational Awareness.

- 2. The annual leadership institute sponsored by the Order of the Knights of Rizal offers opportunities for students to enrich their off-campus education in the areas of character-building, citizenship training, personal discipline, and progressive leadership. The institute will appraise and evaluate the ideals and teachings of Rizal which find relevance in our contemporary society.
- 3. Five (5) sub-topics will be discussed, namely: Rizal in Today's Nationalism, Rizal and the Brotherhood of Men, Rizal: Relevance of History to National Development, Rizal and National Identity, and Rizal and National Security.
- 4. Speakers in the seminar include Assemblyman Salvador H. Laurel, Mational Defense Deputy Minister Carmelo Barbero, former Education and Culture Deputy Minister Narciso Albarracin, former Senator Francisco "Soc" Rodrigo, and Professor Jose David Lapuz. Acting Minister Hermenegildo C. Dumlao will be the keynote speaker.
- 5. All secondary schools, colleges and universities, public and private, are urged to send delegates to the

institute. Their attendance will be official. An institutional assistance fee of #220 to cover transportation expenses from Manila to Baguio City and back; board and lodging; convention portfolio with reading materials; certificate of attendance; etc. shall be charged each participant. Students from government institutions may charge the amount against local funds subject to availability of funds and the usual accounting and auditing regulations. Participants from the private sector may charge the fee against their respective institutions.
