- 1. Pursuant to Sec. 29, Article V of P.D. No. 44 entitled "Drug Education in the Curriculum in All Levels of Education", the Ministry of Education and Culture has adopted a drug education program as part of the administration's five-pronged approach to primary health welfare to safeguard the health of the general public, especially that of the students.
- 2. In line with this program, the Dangerous Drugs Board, the Ministry of Health, and the Ministry of Education and Culture have jointly coordinated efforts and approved various books and monographs for use in drug education.
- 3. In view of the above, this Office suggests that a high priority be given to the acquisition of drug education materials through the use of local resources and initiative, in order to promote the proper use of drugs.
- 4. It may be mentioned in this connection that the Boy Scouts of the Philippines has taken initiative to launch an anti-drug abuse and fund campaign, the proceeds from which are intended to support projects in drug education.
- 5. Immediate dissemination of the contents of this Memorandum is desired.
