INSTRUCTIONAL MATERIALS ON CREDIT CONSCIOUSNESS

To: Bureau Directors
Regional Directors

Presidents, State Colleges and Universities

Administrators of Non-Chartered Schools/Colleges

1. The instructional materials on Credit Consciousness consisting of five modules developed under the joint project of the Ministry of Education and Culture and the National Commission on Countryside Credit and Collection (NCCCC) shall be distributed during October and November this year to both private and state colleges and universities for integration in such social science subjects as Current Issues, Contemporary National Development, Economics, and such other subjects which lend themselves naturally to integration of credit consciousness concepts.
2. These modules are designed to create awareness of the different credit programs of the government which can be availed of by the citizenry as well as to inculcate among the people the value of being good creditors. This government thrust serves as an important adjunct in countryside development.
3. An Instructor's Manual accompanies each set of fifty modules to guide the instructor in using the modules.
4. Considering the importance of credit consciousness in the pursuit of the goals of national development, it is desired that college/university recipients maximize the utilization of these instructional materials starting the second semester of school year 1980-1981.

5. A monitoring team will make periodic assessment of the utilization of said materials.
