TRAINING WORKSHOP ON CURRICULUM EVALUATION AND IMPROVEMENT

To: Bureau Directors
Regional Directors
Schools Superintendents

1. The Ministry of Education and Culture, through the Bureau of Secondary Education will hold a training workshop for Curriculum Evaluation and Improvement on November 10-21, 1980 at Teachers' Camp, Baguio City as part of the Program and Projects Review, Phase II. This is a joint project of the Staff Development Program of the MEC and of the Development in Secondary Education Program of the Bureau of Secondary Education.

2. The objective of the training workshop is to train a core of MEC and field personnel in secondary education who will be able to:

- a. assess the existing secondary education program and its capability to meet the needs of the Filipino high school learner and his society;
 - (1) to determine if the present curriculum equips students with all the basic skills and concepts needed for either a vocational or an academic pursuit; and
 - (2) to find out whether the present curriculum meets the varying needs and interests of the different sectors of the high school age population.
- b. determine the teacher training and instructional materials support needed for the proper implementation of the program; and
- c. make recommendations and proposals for the improvement of the secondary school program and its implementation.

3. The following are to attend the seminar-workshop:

- a. The Chief or Assistant Chief of each regional secondary education division 13

- b. A participant with experience and/or formal training in curriculum development and evaluation from each region 13
- c. A representative from each of the Curriculum Development Centers 4
- d. BSE Staff Members 20
 - Chief/Assistant Chief of each Division.... 3
 - Researchers from the:
 - Curriculum Development Division10
 - Staff Development Division 3
 - Physical Facilities Division 1
 - Clerk Typist 3

4. Inclosed is a program of activities of the training workshop.

5. Travel expenses of participants from their stations to Manila and back will be charged against local funds. Transportation from Manila to Baguio and back including board and lodging expenses will be charged against the Office of the Minister of Education and Culture funds for Staff Development, subject to the usual accounting and auditing regulations.

6. It is desired that this Memorandum be disseminated for the information and guidance of all concerned.
