- 1. A National Seminar-Workshop on Curriculum and Testing will be conducted by the Bureau of Elementary Education at the BEE Monitoring Room and Covelandia, Binakayan, Kawit, Cavite on November 13-21, 1980.
- 2. The objective of the seminar-workshop is to work out, prior to the signing of the loan agreement, the requirements for the proposed sector loan for elementary education (PRODED). Specifically, the participants are expected to:
 - a. develop a simplified core curriculum that will strongthen the elementary sector;
 - acquire skills in developing tests and interpreting test results necessary for more effective monitoring and evaluation of PRODED sector projects; and
 - c. improve their management capability for PRODED implementation.
- 3. The participants in the seminar will include the chiefs of the elementary education divisions of the thirteen (13) MEC Regional Offices and selected personnel from the Bureau of Elementary Education.
- 4. Mr. J. Ratnaike, UNESCO Educational Adviser, will be the guest consultant in the Seminar-Workshop.
- 5. All expenses incident to the attendance of the participants to this seminar-workshop shall be charged against the funds for programs and projects of the Bureau of Elementary Education, subject to the usual auditing and accounting rules and regulations.
