1980-1981 LEVEL II SEMINAR-WORKSHOP ON PREVENTIVE  
DRUG EDUCATION FOR TRAINERS

To: Bureau Directors  
Regional Directors  
Schools Superintendents  
Presidents, State Colleges and Universities

1. The UP-MEC National Drug Education Program will conduct the 1980-1981 Level II Training Program on Preventive Drug Education for Trainers at the College of Education, University of the Philippines, Roxas Avenue, Diliman, Quezon City, from January 12 to 24, 1981. Inclosed is a list of participating divisions/institutions.

2. The overall objective is to provide intensive training on drug education to trainers. Specifically, the seminar-workshop aims to develop among the participants competencies which will enable them to:

- a. develop keener sensitivity to the problems of drug abuse;
- b. increase awareness of socio-psycho-cultural factors influencing drug abuse;
- c. improve, upgrade and develop curriculum materials for drug education integrated with health education and other allied areas of study;
- d. acquire innovative strategies for teaching/learning;
- e. develop competencies in evaluating drug education;
- f. acquire scientific skills and techniques for identifying, handling and referring suspected cases of drug abuse;

- g. develop skills in coordinating and cooperating with private, civic and government agencies concerned with education, regulation and control of drug abuse; and
  - h. develop training programs for preventive drug education at the elementary and secondary schools and teacher education colleges.
3. The trainers who will undergo this Level III training will be composed of the following:
- a. One (1) school physician
  - b. One (1) health education supervisor
  - c. One (1) guidance counselor
  - d. One (1) elementary or high school teacher, preferably teaching health education
  - e. One (1) teacher from teacher training institutions, preferably one teaching health education in the pre-service program.

These trainers are expected to work as a team in planning and conducting the Level III Drug Education Training Program for selected principals and elementary/high school teachers in their respective provinces or cities. The personnel who will undergo the Level III training are expected to conduct the Level IV Drug Education Training Program with assistance from the trainers in their respective schools. Levels III and IV training programs are to be financed from local funds.

4. The names of the participants should be sent to the Office of the Dean, College of Education, University of the Philippines, Diliman, Quezon City, on or before December 1, 1980. Participants are requested to bring with them instructional materials, visual aids and other devices which they have been using in preventive drug education.

5. The team from each province/city is expected to prepare a brief report based on the outline below. It is suggested that the health education supervisor convene the team and provide the leadership in the preparation of the report.

- a. Status of the drug abuse problem in the province or city
- b. Causes of drug abuse
- c. What is being done to prevent or control drug abuse:
  - (1) Agencies actively involved
  - (2) Problems of law enforcement and other agencies in combating influx of drugs
- d. Preventive drug education program:
  - (1) Elementary and secondary schools
  - (2) Teacher education colleges
    - a) pre-service
    - b) in-service
  - (3) Community
  - (4) Problems and issues encountered

The report should be sent to the Dean, College of Education, University of the Philippines, Diliman, Quezon City on or before December 19, 1980.

6. Travel expenses to U.P. and back to the division, per diem of P35.00 a day and daily allowance of P10.00 for 14 days will be charged against the funds of the project which is being supported by the Dangerous Drugs Board subject to the usual accounting and auditing rules and regulations.

7. Although this is not a live-in seminar-workshop, the participants who may wish to live in campus should inform the Dean, College of Education, U.P., if they wish to make a reservation at the Benitez Memorial Center, Magsaysay Avenue, which charges P30.00/day for lodging only.

8. Immediate dissemination of this Memorandum is desired.
