- e. Organize activities such as story telling, dramatic presentations, etc., to encourage reading;
- f. Invite parents of the pupils to visit school libraries; and
- g. Conduct visits to a local library.

MUSIC WORKSHOP ON THE KODALY
METHOD OF TEACHING CHORUSES

1 This is to inform the field that the Cultural Center of the Philippines in cooperation with the National Music Competitions for Young Artists Executive Board, the University of the Philippines College of Music, and the Ministry of Education and Culture, is sponsoring a Music Workshop on the "Kodaly Method of Teaching Choruses" to be held at the University of the Philippines College of Music, Diliman Campus, Quezon City, on May 19-June 6, 1981, from 9 00 a. m. to 12 00 noon and from 2 00 p. m. to 5 00 p. m., on Mondays and Fridays

2 The Kodaly method of teaching music was developed by the eminent Hungarian composer Zoltan Kodaly and is now widely used throughout Europe. The leading exponents and experts of the method, Mr and Mrs Georgy Gulyas, have been invited to lecture and share with us their expertise and experience. This year's seminar is the first of a projected four-year program on this method. Participants for 1981 shall enroll in the Level I class which shall deal primarily on fundamentals of the Kodaly Method. Only participants who shall have passed this level can be admitted to Level II in 1982.

3 Participation is strictly by invitation. Choral conductors and/or music teachers with a degree in Music and those who are actively handling choruses for the past five years are invited. A total fee of one thousand pesos (P1,000) is required per participant covering two hundred pesos (P200) non-refundable registration fee and eight hundred pesos (P800) actual seminar fee. The quota of participants is limited to fifty (50) to be accommodated on a first-come-first-serve basis. Deadline for registration is February 15, 1981.

4. All Regional music supervisors of the Ministry of Education and Culture are invited to the workshop, including one person subject to the recommendation of the regional director addressed to the Seminar Committee on Admission composed of Mrs. Flora Z. Rivera, Workshop Director, Mr. David Yap and Mrs. Alice A. Jalape, Assistant Workshop Directors, and Dr. Lucrecia R. Kasilag, President of the Cultural Center of the Philippines. All regional music supervisors shall be automatically admitted to the workshop. They will be required to furnish a copy of their C S Form 212 (Personal Data Sheet). In the case of other personnel recommended, it is requested that they submit their C S Form 212 with emphasis on choral experience for screening purposes. They shall then be notified as soon as their papers are evaluated.

5. Expenses incident to this workshop, including transportation and per diems as well as the workshop fee, shall be shouldered by the respective regional offices, subject to the usual accounting and auditing regulations.

6. Dissemination of this Memorandum to all concerned is desired.
