- This is to inform the field that the Cultural Center of the Philippines in cooperation with the National Music Competitions for Young Artists Executive Board, the University of the Philippines College of Music, and the Ministry of Education and Culture, is sponsoring a Mu ic Workshop on the "Kodaly Method of Teachin, Choruses" to be held at the University of the Philippines College of Husic, Diliman Campus, Quezon City, on May 19-June 6, 1981, from 9 00 a m. to 12 00 noon and from 2 00 p m to 5 00 p m, on Mondays and Fridays
- The kodaly method of teaching music was developed by the eminent Hungarian composer Zoltan Kodaly and is now widely used throughout Europe.
