REGIONAL CONFERENCES TO IMPLEMENT THE CURRICULUM
MATERIALS ON AGRARIAN REFORM (PHASE I)

To: Bureau Directors
Regional Directors
Chiefs of Services and Heads of Units
Schools Superintendents
Presidents, State Colleges and Universities
Heads of Private Schools Colleges
and Universities

1. The Ministry of Education and Culture, in cooperation with the Ministry of Agrarian Reform, will conduct regional conferences from January 19 to 30, 1981, to implement the curriculum materials on agrarian reform developed for elementary, secondary and higher education levels for integration into appropriate subject areas.

2. Instructional materials developed for the following academic grade levels shall be fully implemented during the current school year 1980-81:

- a. Higher Education - Modules 1 to 10 (English and Pilipino Editions)
- b. Secondary Education - Second, Third and Fourth Year Teachers' Guides
- c. Elementary Education - Grades Two and Three Readers and Manual Grades Four, Five and Six Teachers' Guides and Accompanying Posters

In Metro Manila, Kinder Posters for Kindergarten and Grade One Reader shall also be implemented together with Grades Two, Three, Four, Five and Six instructional materials.

3. The implementation activity shall be limited to the same school divisions of each region as in the initial implementation phase conducted during the school year 1978-1979, as stated in MEC Memorandum No. 317, s. 1978, as follows:

III	Nueva Ecija including Canatuan City, Palayan City and San Jose City
IV	Batangas including Batangas City and Lipa City
V	Albay including Legazpi City
VI	Iloilo including Iloilo City
VII	Cebu including Cebu City, Lapu-Lapu City, Mandawe City, Toledo City and Danao City
VIII	Leyte including Tacloban City and Ormoc City
IX	Zamboanga City
X	Misamis Oriental including Cagayan de Oro City and Gingoog City
XI	Davao City
XII	Cotabato City
NCR	Metro Manila

5. The activities in each region shall be held in two days. Conference for Grades Two and Three (including Grade One in Metro Manila) of the elementary level and that for the Second, Third and Fourth Years of the secondary level shall be held simultaneously on the first day. Conference for Grades Four, Five and Six of the elementary level and that of the higher level shall be held simultaneously on the second day. Regional directors and schools superintendents shall decide the conference venues for the elementary, secondary and higher levels. Inclosed is a list of members of the MAR-MEC curriculum teams who will conduct the regional conferences and the participants in these regional conferences.

6. Regional directors and other officials of the Ministry of Education and Culture shall coordinate with their local counterparts from the Ministry of Agrarian Reform for the successful administration of the regional activity.

7. Accordingly, all bureau and regional directors are enjoined to inform and allow the participants to attend the conferences on official time. Travel expenses, per diems and allowances of the MAR-MEC curriculum teams who will conduct the conferences shall be charged against the Fund for Agrarian Reform Education (FARE) of the Ministry of Agrarian Reform.

8. Immediate dissemination of this Memorandum is desired.
