a. Start of the Contest

National Level February 25, 1981

4 What to Submit

- a. An essay in English of not less than 800 words in 5 copies.

 The manuscript should be typewritten double-spaced on legal size bond paper
- b. The entry should indicate at the upper left hand corner of the first page the name of the school and the year level of the author. It should be signed by the author at the bottom of every page.
- c. Each entry should be certified by the Principal/Director/Head Teacher as the case may be, of the school that it is the original work of the author

5. Where and When to Submit

- a. School Level The essay(s) should be submitted to the school Principal/Director/Head Teacher not later than January 5, 1981
- b. <u>Division Level</u> Every school entry should be submitted by the school Principal/Director/Head Teacher to the Division Superintendent not later than January 20, 1931
- c. Regional Level The winning essay in the division level should be submitted by the Division Superintendent to the Regional Director not later than February 5, 1981

National and/or regional winners from outside the National Capital Region shall claim their prizes through the MEC Regional Director having jurisdiction over the schools where the winning writers are enrolled. Transportation cost to and from the Regional Office plus accommodation expenses for two days of the national winners and their official chaperons will be shouldered by the NTRC
