NINETEENTH ANNUAL NATIONAL CONVENTION OF THE PHILIPPINE
ASSOCIATION FOR GRADUATE EDUCATION

To: Bureau Directors
Regional Directors
Presidents, State Colleges and Universities
Heads of Private Schools, Colleges and Universities

1. The Philippine Association for Graduate Education (PAGE) will hold its nineteenth annual national convention on January 19-21, 1981, at Bacolod City. The convention, co-sponsored by the Fund for Assistance to Private Education (FAPE) and the Ministry of Education and Culture, will be hosted by PAGE VI and MEC Region VI. The venues for the three-day convention will be the West Negros College, the University of Negros Occidental-Recoletos, the La Salle College and the University of San Agustin Extension Campus.
2. The theme of the convention is: "The Graduate Thesis/Dissertation." In keeping with the focus on quality of graduate education, the principal objective of the convention is to create an intense awareness of the true mission of research as an instrument for the advancement of knowledge. The topics to be taken up during the convention include the thesis format, the thesis writer, the thesis adviser, the thesis committee, and the thesis defense, which will be discussed by Dr. Aida C. Caluag, Dr. Felipe L. de Guzman, Dr. Melecio C. Deauna, Brother Rafael S. Donato, Dr. Paz Policarpio Mendez and Dr. Concesa Milan-Baduel, respectively.
3. A convention fee of ₱120 for snacks, conference kit and materials and other necessary expenses will be charged each participant.
4. In the interest of graduate education, each college or university offering graduate studies is enjoined to send its dean of graduate school and/or chairman of either or both business or arts to the convention. Expenses for school representatives shall be borne by the institutions concerned. The Chief of the Higher Education Division of each MEC regional office is enjoined to attend this convention on official time; provided, however, that their travel expenses shall be charged against the funds of their respective agencies, subject to auditing rules and regulations.
