COMPETITIVE EXAMINATION FOR THE PRESIDENT FERDINAND E. MARCOS SCHOLARSHIP PROGRAM FOR FISHERIES

To: Bureau Directors
Regional Directors
Schools Superintendents
Presidents, State Colleges and Universities
Heads of Private Schools, Colleges and Universities

- that an open and competitive examination for the purpose of selecting scholars under the President Ferdinand E. Marcos Scholarship Program for Fisherics will be conducted on February 14, 1981 in 13 regional testing centers to be designated by the MEC regional directors. The examination is for 2-½ hours and will include test items in the Sciences (Biology, Chemistry and Physics), Mathematics (Applied Arithmetic, Algebra and Geometry), English (Grammar and Reading Comprehension), and Basic Fisheries. It will be administered in each region by the FEM Scholarship Program Secretariat assisted by a maximum of five (5) proctors designated by the MEC regional director.
- 2. The results of this examination and the list of fishery schools and colleges where the successful examinees may enroll as FEM scholars will be announced in March 1981, copy furnished the office of the provincial/city school superintendents through the MEC Regional Director.
  - 3. The FEM Scholarship Program for Fisheries, under LOI 1014 dated April 19, 1980, provides for school year 1980-1981 a maximum of five (5) scholars per region for college studies leading to the degree of Bachelor of Science in Fisheries.
  - 4. A scholar under this program will be estitled to: a) free matriculation and other school fees; b) book allowance per semester; c) monthly stipend of 7700; and d) thesis support and graduation expenses.
  - 5. High school graduates/graduating students who are certified to by their respective school heads as among the top ten in the graduating class to which they belong, based on their final grades in all required third and fourth year subjects, in the case of high school graduates of on their third final grades in all required third year subjects and ratings during the first and second grading periods in all required fourth year subjects, in the case of those graduating from high school fourth year subjects, in the case of those graduating from high school during the school year 1980-1981, are eligible to take the competitive examination for this scholarship program. It is understood that the applicants are Filipino citizens, of good moral standing, physically fit, free from any criminal, civil or administrative liability, and genuinely interested to pursue college studies in fisheries.

- 6. Applicants for scholarship under this program should file their application on or before January 9, 1981 using the inclosed application form, through the Provincial/City FEM Scholarship Screening Committee. The Committee shall be composed of the provincial/city school superintendent as Chairman, the Provincial Governor/City Mayor as Co-Chairman, and Assemblyman representing the province, the President of the Local Mayor's league and the BFAR Provincial Program Officer, as members. Application forms may be obtained from the office of the provincial/city schools superintendent.
- 7. The provincial/city schools superintendent shall forward the applications of qualified applicants, through the MEC Regional Director, to the FEM Scholarship Program Secretarios, iroadia Bidg., 860 Queson Avenue, Quezon City, Metro Manila to reach the said Office on or before January 26, 1981.
- 8. It is desired that the contents of this Memorandum be immediately disseminated and given the widest publicity possible for the information and guidance of all concerned.
