CASH ASSISTANCE TO TEACHERS FOR TEACHING AIDS
AND CLASSROOM SUPPLIES

To: Bureau Directors
Regional Directors
Schools Superintendents

1. Teachers are hereby encouraged to prepare their own teaching aids, particularly flip charts, flash cards, pictures and other forms of educational materials of similar nature to ensure that such teaching aids/instructional materials most closely meet the specific needs of individual teachers and learners to maximize teaching-learning outcomes.
2. Effective January 1, 1981, assistance in cash shall be provided for this purpose, to cover the cost of materials, labor, ideas and other pertinent expenses, to be disbursed to the teachers concerned in accordance with the rules and regulations that shall be promulgated by the Ministry of Education and Culture, Ministry of the Budget and the Commission on Audit, pursuant to Special Provision No. 2 of BP Blg. 40 and LOI No. 1043, dated July 16, 1980. The amount, likewise, shall cover the cost of common classroom supplies such as chalk, class record booklets and forms, erasers, and other essential supplies and materials directly used by teachers.
3. In view hereof, the purchase by the schools, schools divisions, and regional offices of the aforementioned types of teaching aids is temporarily suspended effective immediately.
4. Immediate dissemination of the contents of this Memorandum is desired.
