TWELFTH ANNUAL NATIONAL CONFERENCE OF THE PHILIPPINE  
ASSOCIATION FOR TEACHER EDUCATION

To: Bureau Directors  
Regional Directors  
Schools Superintendents

Heads of Private Schools, Colleges  
and Universities

1. The Philippine Association for Teacher Education (PAFTE) will hold its twelfth annual national convention on January 16-17 at the Pope Pius XII Center, United Nations Avenue, Manila. Co-sponsors of the annual convention are the Fund for Assistance to Private Education (FAPE) and the Ministry of Education and Culture.
2. The theme of the national conference is "Perspectives for Teacher Education in the 80s." The major objective is to serve as a national consultation on the Five-Year PAFTE Plan for development education. To achieve this goal, specific objectives are set up: a) to clarify the values needed to strengthen the teacher education program for development education; b) to identify needs and problems of teacher education administrators; c) to produce the needed guidelines for the subject matter content for the effective implementation of ITEP; d) to prioritize needs and problems of teacher educators with regard to instructional materials development and teaching strategies; e) to determine areas of cooperation among PAFTE members; f) to explore areas of regional concern in teacher education for purposes of research; and g) to assess initial efforts in the organization of local chapters.
3. A convention fee of P50 will be charged to cover registration fee, convention papers, and snacks.

4. Each school, college or university offering teacher education is enjoined to send its dean of teacher education to the conference. Expenses for school representatives shall be borne by the institutions concerned. The chief of the higher education division in each MEC regional office is likewise enjoined to attend this convention on official time. Travel expenses shall be charged against the funds of the respective agency, subject to the usual auditing rules and regulations.

5. Immediate and wide dissemination of this Memorandum to all concerned is desired.
