VOCATIONAL EDUCATORS CONFERENCE

To: Bureau Directors  
Regional Directors  
Schools Superintendents  
Presidents, State Colleges and Universities  
Heads of Private Schools, Colleges and Universities  
Vocational School Superintendents/Administrators

1. The Ministry of Education and Culture jointly with the Philippine Association for Vocational Education (PAVE), Inc., will hold a Vocational Educators Conference at the Teachers Camp, Baguio City on May 26-28, 1981.

2. The objectives of the conference are:

- a. to make a preliminary assessment of the Vocational-Technical Production Program with emphasis on its problems and success factors;
- b. to make an evaluation of all laws affecting vocational/technical education in the light of present trends and conditions in support of future vocational education legislations;
- c. to finalize the results of the survey of vocational/technical institutions as fielded by the Planning Service of the Ministry of Education and Culture; and
- d. to determine ways by which the programs in vocational institutions may be effectively coordinated.

3. The participants to this conference are:

- a. heads of vocational, trade, agriculture, fishery, craftsmen and comprehensive schools
- b. regional/division vocational education supervisors
- c. school chapter representatives of the Philippine Association for Vocational Education (PAVE), Inc.

4. Travel expenses of participants, including a conference fee of ₱300 to cover conference hall rentals, conference materials and other operating expenses, shall be charged against local school funds, subject to the usual accounting and auditing rules and regulations.

5. The Director of the Bureau of Secondary Education is designated coordinator of this activity and shall create commissions and appoint members thereto to effectively implement the interest and purposes of this conference.

6. In view of the importance and the benefits the Ministry shall gain through this conference in terms of policy formulation and towards effective implementation of vocational/technical education programs, the full cooperation of all concerned is desired.

7. It is requested that this Memorandum be given the widest publicity possible.
