SECOND ANNUAL NATIONAL CONVENTION OF THE PHILOSOPHY  
OF EDUCATION SOCIETY OF THE PHILIPPINES

To: Bureau Directors  
Regional Directors  
Schools Superintendents  
Presidents, State Colleges and Universities  
Heads of Private Schools, Colleges and Universities

1. The Philosophy of Education Society of the Philippines (PESP) will hold its second annual national convention on February 26-27, 1981, at the Health Auditorium, Philippine Normal College Manila. The convention co-sponsored by the Fund for Assistance to Private Education (FAPE) and the Ministry of Education and Culture, will be hosted by the Philippine Normal College.

2. The theme of the convention is: "Disciplines and the Man: Development of a Filipino Ideology." The objectives of the convention are:

- a. to re-examine various issues in the disciplines of political science, history, economics, literature and the arts and sciences which affect education;
- b. to intensify awareness on the values, beliefs and ways of life which enhance one's capacity for freedom, social justice, national identity and unity;
- c. to draw educational theories from the different disciplines which direct educational practice; and;
- d. to identify research areas in the field of philosophy of education.

3. Philosophy of education instructors and college deans are enjoined to attend the convention for which they will be charged a convention fee of P110 for snacks, lunch, dinner and conference materials. Expenses of school representatives shall be borne by the institutions concerned. The Chief of the Higher Education Division of each MEC regional office and senior edu-

cational researchers are encouraged to attend this convention on official time; provided, however, that their travel expenses and other expenses incurred relative to such attendance shall be charged against the funds of their respective agencies, subject to auditing rules and regulations.

4. Immediate dissemination and implementation of this Memorandum is desired.
