SEVENTH NATIONAL CONFERENCE OF CHIEFS AND ASSISTANT
CHIEFS OF THE ELEMENTARY EDUCATION DIVISION,
REGIONAL OFFICES

To: Bureau Directors

1. The Seventh National Conference of Chiefs and Assistant Chiefs of the MECRO elementary education divisions to be hosted by MEC Region V, in coordination with the Bureau of Elementary Education, will be held at Legazpi City from February 16 to 20, 1981. The theme of the conference is "Elementary Education for the Development of a Sense of Nationhood."

2. The conference aims to enable the participants to plan programs and projects for school year 1981-82 geared towards the development of a sense of nationhood through the implementation of PRODED and other elementary education thrusts. Specifically they will:

- a. react to the mission and values thrust of elementary education;
- b. provide inputs into the proposed core-curriculum for elementary education;
- c. give reactions to the accountability map;
- d. get acquainted with the new Performance Appraisal System for Teachers; and
- e. discuss plans for the implementation of PRODED and other elementary education projects for 1981 in terms of:

- (1) staff development and technical assistance,
 - (2) instructional materials development,
 - (3) facilities and equipment, and
 - (4) civil works.
3. The participants are requested to bring to the conference the following:
- a. The basic documents of the Mission and Values Team of PRODED distributed during the seminar-workshop in Covelandia last November 1980.
 - b. Plans and schedules of implementation of PRODED for 1981 and 1982.
 - c. Status reports on existing projects.
4. Each participant shall be charged a registration fee of ₱200. Expenses incident to the attendance of the participants to this conference shall be charged against local funds, subject to the usual accounting and auditing rules and regulations.
5. Inclosed is the Tentative Schedule of Activities for the conference.
6. Immediate dissemination of this Memorandum to all concerned is requested.
