- 4. Immediate dissemination of this Memorandum particularly to secondary and vocational school heads, public and private, and other officials concerned is desired.

Dear Minister Corpuz:

I refer to the attached letter dated January 8, 1981 from Mr. Vicente Poblador of Taguig, "etro-Manila relative to his request for assistance in connection with efforts to locate his missing daughter, Marivic L. Poblador, who was believed kidnapped by one Luzviminda Labao and her common law husband, Danilo Publico on October 13, 1979.

Mr. Poblador informs this Office that independent inquiries about the whereabouts of his daughter, now 16 years old, indicated that her abductors may have been sending Marivic to school in an undetermined locality. Wishing to exhaust all possibilities to locate his daughter, Mr. Poblador now wants to explore the feasibility of requesting all secondary and vocational schools under your supervision to indicate whether they have a student answering Marivic's description, a request I most respectfully endorse for your appropriate action, so as to allow further steps to be taken to recover the girl.

I have requested Mr. Poblador to proceed to your office relative to the above. In the interim, law enforcement units under this Ministry will continue efforts to locate the girl and her abductors.

Thank you very musch for sharing with us this opportunity for a small public service.

residents of No. 11 Col. Ballezer Street, Zone 4 Signal
Village, Taguig, Metro-Manila whose 13-year old daughter,
MARIVIC POBLADOR, a second year high school student was
surreptitiously brought away from them, at their place in
Taguig: Metro-Manila by a woman, Luzviminda L. Publico on Taguig, Metro Mentle by a woman, Luzviminda L. Publico on October 43, 1979 and has not been heard of since then.

Luzviminda took advantage of the fact that she took care of the child, auring her infancy up to the time she was 2 years of age, and even at this age, the child frequents the house she stayed in, just next to that of the Pobladors'. A true copy

Luzviminda has lived with 2 different men without benefit of marriage. At the time she took the missing child, she was living with Danilo Publico, a family man, and a driver off and on by occupation. Herself, Luzviminda depended principally on the Pobladors for her subsistence, as she has been jobless, with no visible source of livelihood, even on October 13, 1979.

Records of the Office of the Provincial Fiscal of Rizal show that the persons referred to in this letter are now residing at 79 G. Villanueva, Pasay City, although the parents entertained doubts as to the veracity of their actual residence.

The child, an adolescent girl at that, in the company of these 2 irresponsible characters is precariously in the midst of a risk she herself least realize. May I enlist your kind assistance in behalf of the parents, who has suffered mental torture and anguish for the safety of their g daughters / Villag Villag

With assurances of my faith in your consistent and known capability to uphold what is right, and with my deep esteem and regards.

The undersigned most respectfully appeal for assistance in connection with our daughter, Marivic Poblador, 14 years old, who have been missing since October 13, 1979. Suspects are Luzviminda Labao and Danilo Publico of unknown address and remain missing up to the present.

Based on the following grounds to wit:

- (a) That I have sought the assistance of the Philippine Constabulary on February 16, 1980 but up to the present, no words have been received from the authorities. Xerox copy of appeal attached for reference.
- (b) That said loss or missing status of our daughter have likewise been the subject of my complaint against Luzviminda Labao and Danilo Publico filed with the Provincial Fiscal Office of Pasig on December 6, 1979. Xerox copy of complaint attached for reference.
- (c) That this missing status had been announced several times in all news media. Xerox public service attached for reference.

That also an aftermath to said lost daughter, my wife have often got sick in the hospital.

Your honor, my humble family and myself will long cherish your earliest possible action at your convenience for the sake of an agonizing mother to see once more our child before anything happens to her.
