NFE-OSY SUMMER SPORTS PROGRAM

To: Bureau Directors
Regional Directors
Chiefs of Services and Heads of Units
Schools Superintendents
Presidents, State Colleges and Universities
Heads of Private Schools, Colleges and

1. Sports and physical fitness development is one of the seven areas of concern in the country-wide program of nonformal education under the Ministry of Education and Culture.
2. To further promote sports development among the out-of-school youth the NFE-OSY Summer Sports Program is being launched. The purpose of this program is to encourage more active participation of our out-of-school youth in various sports activities to develop their prowess, sportsmanship, teamwork, and the spirit of fair play.
3. All regions and the school divisions under them are encouraged to organize various teams composed of OSYs to participate in this program. All school facilities, equipment and athletic supplies should, as much as possible, be used by the out-of-school youth under supervision by responsible teachers or by the district NFE coordinators themselves to ensure their proper use.
4. To supplement the existing schools' sports facilities and equipment the Office of Nonformal Education has purchased from its own funds a limited number of basketball, volleyball, softball and baseball bats and gloves. These athletic supplies will be proportionately distributed to the 13 regions including the National Capital Region through the regional directors who, in turn, will apportion the athletic supplies to their respective school divisions. As the number available is very limited, the apportionment should be made on the basis of priority needs. Another basis for distribution should be the number of potential OSYs who could be developed into good players in a certain sport or game.

5. It is desired that division NFE supervisors form OSY sports teams for competition purposes and division sports council to help in the management of the NFE-OSY summer sports program.

6. A report on the status of these athletic supplies/sports program should be submitted periodically to the Office of Nonformal Education, Ministry of Education and Culture, Manila.

7. Immediate dissemination of the contents of this Memorandum is desired.
