CONTINUING EDUCATION PROGRAM FOR MUSIC TEACHERS,
MUSICIANS, AND LAYMEN FOR SUMMER 1981

1. The UP Musical Arts and Research Management Foundation, in cooperation with the UP College of Music, will hold its Summer 1981 Program for Continuing Education in Music to be offered at the UP College of Music, Diliman, Quezon City. The program consists of short-term non-degree courses in various aspects of music and music education. It is designed to meet the educational needs of individuals engaged in the following areas in music:

- a. Classroom teaching
- b. Choral conducting
- c. Composition and arranging
- d. Theater

2. Completion of all course offerings of the entire program (staggered within 4 summer periods) is meant to provide music competence and proficiency particularly useful to teachers, and will earn for the participant a Program Certificate. A Certificate of Attendance will also be issued for each completed course.

3. The following are the courses offered for summer 1981 and their equivalent fees:

- a. Basic Functional Harmony II P150.00
- b. Music Appreciation 150.00
- c. Music Teaching Strategies in
High School 150.00
- d. Organizing Youth and Adult Choirs,
Conducting Techniques and Repertoire 150.00

- e. Workshop in Orff and Schulwerk (Basic). . . 150.00
- f. Piano, Guitar, Voice III 150.00

4. In view of the benefits that will be derived from attendance in this program, it is desired that music teachers and supervisors be encouraged to enrol therein. Regional and division offices are also enjoined to give financial assistance to staff members who will enroll in the courses and who may be utilized for teacher training in Music.

5. Enrolment and payment of fees are done one day before the first session of the course. For more detailed information, announcement brochures are available upon request at:
