d) Country of participant

e) Four (4) pictures/photos of participant

- The awarding of prizes will be made in June, 1981. in the presence of the diplomatic body accredited in Mexico, state governors, education and culture officials and authorities, representatives of the Mexican national press; and the "Diario de Mexico" directorate.
- Prizes, which will consist of a medal and diploma for first place, and a diploma for second place, will be awarded to the ambassadors of the country of the winners who will in turn send them to the winners in their country of origin.
- It is desired that as many students as are interested be encouraged to participate in the contest.
