SUMMER SCHOLARSHIP PROGRAM ON SPECIAL EDUCATION

To: Bureau Directors  
Regional Directors  
Schools Superintendents  
Presidents, State Colleges and Universities  
Heads of Private Schools, Colleges  
and Universities

1. The Ministry of Education and Culture, through the facilities of the National Research and Development Centre for Teacher Education (NRDCTE), the Baguio Vacation Normal School (BVNS) and the Baguio City Schools SPED Center, is offering scholarship on Special Education beginning this summer of 1981 at the BVNS, Teachers Camp, Baguio City. Classes for this particular program will be held from April 20 to May 16.

2. The subjects to be offered with the corresponding unit credits are as follows:

3. After two consecutive summer terms, the participant is expected to finish 18 units of the course requirements. This will entitle him to a Certificate of Proficiency in Special Education.

4. Each regional office will be given four scholarship slots. The candidates selected by the Special Education Screening Committee of the Bureau of Elementary Education who are recipients of a two-summer training grant in SPED is found in the inclosed list.

5. For regions without candidates, or have not reached the maximum number of slots, the regional Director shall select the nominees based on the following criteria:

- a. The nominee should be a classroom teacher who is actually handling or is proposed to handle SPED and has not yet undergone desired training in this kind of program.
- b. He should possess good leadership potential and sound mental and physical health.
- c. He should possess appropriate educational qualification and civil service eligibility.
- d. The performance rating for the last three years should at least be "very satisfactory".
- e. He should not be more than 40 years of age.

6. Only in cases where a certain candidate whose name is found in the inclosed list could not avail himself of the scholarship grant may a replacement be made by the regional director. Other supporting documents to be submitted by the nominee are stipulated in paragraph 11 (a-i) of MEC Memorandum No. 29, s. 1981.

7. The names of the selected nominees who were not included in the inclosed list including the alternates should be sent to the Special Education Division, Bureau of Elementary Education, Ministry of Education and Culture, Manila on or before March 31, 1981.

8. A stipend of Seven Hundred and Fifty Pesos (P750) will be provided each participant to cover payment for board and lodging including tuition fees and other miscellaneous expenses. Transportation expenses will be taken from local funds, subject to the usual accounting and auditing requirements.

9. It is desired that the contents of this Memorandum be given the widest publicity possible.
