1981 ANNUAL CONFERENCE-WORKSHOP IN NONFORMAL EDUCATION
FOR PRIVATE SCHOOLS, COLLEGES AND UNIVERSITIES

To: Regional Directors
Schools Superintendents
Heads of Private Schools, Colleges
and Universities

1. The 1981 Annual Conference-Workshop in Nonformal Education for Private Schools, Colleges and Universities will be held on May 28-31, at the ECO-TECH Center, Sudlon, Cebu City. This will be under the auspices of the Private Schools National Association in Nonformal Education (PRISNANFE) with the cooperation and support of the Ministry of Education and Culture and the assistance of the University of San Carlos in Cebu.
2. The primary purpose of the conference-workshop is to provide training for NFE workers in private schools, colleges and universities in planning NFE projects, particularly in preparing project proposals for possible submission to funding agencies, both local and international.
3. Authorized to attend the three-day conference-workshop are the personnel in-charge of Nonformal programs in private schools, colleges and universities, and MEC regional NFE supervisors.
4. A conference fee of P30 to cover the cost of hand-outs, printing of conference proceedings, and social activities will be charged each participant. Board and lodging will be provided by the ECO-TECH Center at P70 a day per person.
5. PRISNANFE will arrange for the transportation and board and lodging for participants representing bona-fide institutional members of the Association. MEC regional NFE supervisors may charge the expenses for their participation against the funds of their regional offices. All others will take charge of their own participation.

. It is desired that each participant to the conference bring along a report (in two copies) of the status of the Non-normal Education program in his school, college or university as of the end of the present school year. A copy of the report will be furnished the Editor, PRISNANFE Newsletter for possible publication.
