DISTRIBUTION OF CURRICULUM MATERIALS AND DEMONSTRATION
TEACHING OF CREDIT CONSCIOUSNESS

To: Bureau Directors
Regional Directors
Chiefs of Services and Heads of Units
Schools Superintendents
Presidents, State Colleges and Universities
Heads of Private Schools, Colleges and Universities

1. The Ministry of Education and Culture, in cooperation with the Central Bank of the Philippines, will conduct regional workshops from June 22 to July 1, 1981 preparatory to the integration of Credit Consciousness in the secondary school curriculum starting the school year 1981-1982.
2. The regional workshops will focus on demonstration teaching in the three subject areas in which Credit Consciousness is to be integrated, namely: Social Studies, Mathematics and Practical Arts. There will be three demonstrations: two in the morning and one in the afternoon. One demonstration will be presented on each of the subject areas specified for any curriculum year level.
3. The regional director will designate the venue of the workshop.
4. A member of the Bureau of Secondary Education staff will be at the regional office one day before the demonstration to render assistance, if desired.
5. The inclosure to this Memorandum gives the timetable as well as the list of participants expected to attend the regional workshops.
6. The transportation allowance for each participant will be charged against local funds subject to

the usual accounting and auditing regulations. Snacks and lunch will be provided by the Central Bank. Arrangement for these, however, will be made by the host division.

7. In connection with this integration of credit consciousness in the curriculum, copies of curriculum materials will be distributed to all the high schools, public and private, in all the divisions throughout the country. The materials which are provided free of charge by the Central Bank of the Philippines will be delivered direct to the school divisions.

8. The schools superintendent is requested to make the allotment to each high school in the division, public and private, the barangay high schools included. The allotment per division is based on the available reports on the school population of the division.

9. Immediate dissemination of this Memorandum to all concerned is desired.
