- In order to further develop a sense of nationalism in our pupils and students, the National Historical Institute of the Ministry of Education and Culture encourages the schools to organize historical tours all over the country.
- 2. In order to expose our youth to key landmarks and places that eloquently evoke our people's rich historical cultural heritage, teachers and instructors in history and other allied subjects are unged to confluct educational tours for the elementary and high school students to different places/landmarks in the region with historical standinance at least once a year.
- the tours in such a way as to make them strategies for lessons in Araling Panglipunan. If this is not possible, tours may be planned in other subjects. It is requested, in this connection, that safety precautions be taken in the conduct of the tours and the loce parentis dictum as provided by law be exercised.
- 4. The National Historical Institute, located at T.M. Kalaw, Ermita, Manila, Tel. Nos. 59-06-46, 57-26-44 and 57-11-59, will serve as the

consultative body for the details of the tours, and will also furnish background materials of historical places and landmarks. It is suggested that historically-inclined civic organizations and provincial/city historical societies/associations be tapped for financial assistance relative to the tours.

5. It is desired that the contents of this Memorandum be widely disseminated to all concerned.
