The 30th Annual Convention and Seminar-Workshop of the Ministry of Education and Culture Dentists Association (MECDA), will be held at the School-Community Health Education Center, Philippine Normal College, Ayala Blvd., Manila on May 6-8, with the theme "The Decade of the Filipino Child Its Implications to the School Dental Health Program."
- 2. School dentists and dental supervisors from public, vocational and private schools are enjoined to participate in the annual convention. The objectives of the seminar-vorkshop are as follows:
 - a. Emphasize the importance of early dental health care through health education.
 - b. Provide a comprehensive dental health care to primary grade pupils both in public and private schools.
 - c. Develop tools for periodic evaluation of the dental health program.
- 3. A convention fee of P50 shall be charged each participant to cover seminar expenses for handouts and other materials. School dentists coming from private schools, colleges and universities, vocational and national high schools may charge their expenses incident to their attendance in the seminar-workshop against local funds. Attendance of other public school dentists shall be on official time only.
