SPECIALIST TRAINING COURSE IN AGRARIAN REFORM
FOR TEACHERS AND SCHOOL OFFICIALS

To: Bureau Directors
Regional Directors
Schools Superintendents
Presidents, State Colleges and Universities
Heads of Private Schools, Colleges and Universities

1. The Baguio Vacation Normal School in coordination with the Ministry of Agrarian Reform will conduct a specialist training course on Agrarian Reform from April 13 to May 2, 1981.
2. This is a special leadership course which is open to graduates and undergraduates and will entitle participants to either a certificate (if taken as non-credit) or 3 units if taken as an elective at the graduate level or towards a field of concentration.
3. Considering that agrarian reform is one of the major thrusts in the educational system, it is urged that each regional office send at least one participant to this course with travel and school expenses chargeable against local funds, subject to the usual auditing and accounting regulations.
4. It is desired that the contents of this Memorandum be immediately disseminated.
