GRADUATION OF SCHOLARS UNDER THE NSDB-PMC
PROJECT 7405 EE

1. The fourth batch of NSDB-PMC scholars with the degrees of Bachelor of Science in Physics Teaching and Bachelor of Science in Mathematics Teaching is graduating by the end of school year 1980-81. This scholarship program was planned to meet the need for competent teachers in Mathematics and Physics in public high schools (including trade, agriculture, and fishery schools and state colleges and universities with high school departments). There will be 16 BSPT and 21 BSMT graduates.
2. The curricular program of instruction under this scholarship program had been designed to be richer and more rigid in content and methods than the regular BSE program to equip the scholars with better background in physics and mathematics teaching.
3. Considering what the graduates of this scholarship program can contribute to effect quality instruction thru content expertise and utilization of varied and innovative approaches and strategies in mathematics and physics teaching, schools are encouraged to give preference to the employment of these graduates, subject to existing Civil Service Commission and Ministry of Education and Culture policies on hiring of personnel.
