SUMMER SCHOLARSHIP PROGRAM ON SCHOOL HEALTH GUARDIAN  
FOR PAGLINGAP SCHOOLS

To: Bureau Directors  
Regional Directors  
Schools Superintendents  
Presidents, State Colleges and Universities  
Heads of Private Schools, Colleges  
and Universities

1. The Ministry of Education and Culture through the cooperation of the School Health and Nutrition Center (SHNC) and the Baguio Vacation Normal School (BVNS) will offer summer scholarship grants to teachers and administrators of the six (6) Paglingap Schools of the country as part of its Staff Development Program. The program will be conducted at the BVNS, Teachers Camp, April 20-May 16, 1981.

2. Participants in this Summer Scholarship Program will compose of 6 teachers, 1 principal or head teacher, 1 district supervisor, 1 division coordinator and 1 curriculum writer of the Paglingap Schools. Paglingap Schools are listed in the inclosure to this Memorandum.

3. The objectives of the Program and the courses to be offered are as follows:

a. Objectives

- (1) To upgrade competencies of teachers and administrators in Paglingap Schools through:
  - (a) development of innovative approach in integrating core concepts in the curriculum;
  - (b) preparation and try-cut materials for use in Paglingap Schools in the country; and

(c) supervision/management of Paglingap Schools.

(2) Develop a model Paglingap Curriculum.

b. Courses

- (1) Curriculum Development Integration of Health and Nutrition Concepts in the Curriculum
- (2) First Aid and Safety Including Identification and Utilization of Medicinal Herbs
- (3) Management of Paglingap Schools for Community Development

4. Payment for board and lodging including tuition fees of each participant will be provided from the IBC Integrated Scholarship Program funds. Transportation expenses will be charged against the budgetary allotments of the School Health and Nutrition Center, subject to the usual accounting and auditing rules and regulations.

5. Participants are expected to bring their prototype curriculum for Project Paglingap and teaching guides, textbooks and other resource/reference materials.

6. It is desired that the contents of this Memorandum be brought to the attention of all concerned.
