NATIONAL SEMINAR IN HOME ECONOMICS

1. The Philippine Home Economics Association (PHEA), in cooperation with the Ministry of Education and Culture, will hold a two-day national seminar on June 30 and July 1, 1981, at the Philamlife Auditorium, United Nations Avenue, Manila.

2. The theme of the seminar is "The Family: A Vital Force in Nation Building".

3. The following are the objectives of the seminar:

- a. Assess the relevance of Home Economics education in terms of vital role of the family in nation building.
- b. Evolve a program of action that will effectively carry out the projects geared towards strengthening and improving the quality of life of individuals and families; and
- c. Strengthen family life education through the development and intensification of desirable Filipino values and professional value attitudes.

4. Participants to this seminar will be regional and division home economics supervisors; officers of home economics associations; district, division, regional, and national levels coordinators; administrators and heads of home economics in public and private schools, colleges and universities, and other H.E.-oriented agencies.

5. A registration fee of fifty pesos (P50) will be charged each delegate to defray cost of materials and other expenses incident to said seminar, including snacks and meals. All expenses that shall be incurred relative to attendance in this seminar may be charged against local funds subject to the usual accounting and auditing regulations.
