IMPLEMENTING PROCEDURE ON THE PHASE-IN/PHASE-OUT PL.N OF THE MEC-CARE SCHOOL FEEDING PROGREM SY 1981-82

To: Regional Directors
Schools Superintendents

- 1. The plan for a 25% reduction of beneficiaries in participating schools in the MEC-CARE school feeding program will be implemented in two phases, as follows:
  - a. Phase I starts in June 1981 for the divisions of Pangasinan, Fueva Ecija, Iloilo, Iloilo City, Cebu, Lapu-Lapu City, Toledo City and Cebu City. These divisions have the highest ratio of beneficiaries to the total school population.
  - b. Phase II starts in October 1981 for the other school divisions.
- 2. The main criterion for the phase-out of school beneficiaries should be the nutritional status of the children. First to be phased-cut are the overweight children and those with normal weight to be followed by children who are mildly underweight until the 25% reduction has been reached.
- The phasing in of schools to take up the 25% reduction will start in October 1981 which is the beginning of the second allocation of CARE commodities.
- 4. \ The selection of schools to be phased\_in should be based on the following criteria:
  - a. School officials and the ETA cencerned must be interested and sincerely committed to cooperate and implement the program for the benefit of the school children.

- b. Selected schools schould be located in economically depressed areas of the division and accessible to local transportation.
- o. High incidence of malnutrition (with at least 30% of children falling under severely or moderately underweight).
- d. School plant and/or community involment will make it possible to provide food production to supplement the school feeding.
- e. Schools should be accessible to local commercial bakery or suitable school bakery that has the facilties with which to handle the program.
- f. PTA should be able to contribute to the financial requirements of the program.

5. Schools superintendents requested to submit the names of schools recommended for the phase-in plan, listed according to priority, using the inclosed form. The lists should reach the School Health and Nutrition Center, MEC, Manila on or before July 15, 1981.
