THIRD COUNTRY COURSE IN THE PHILIPPINES  
ON ACCREDITATION IN TECHNICIAN EDUCATION

1 The Third Country Course in the Philippines on Accreditation in Technician Education will be conducted jointly by the Philippine Government and the Colombo Plan Staff College for Technician Education, Singapore, from June 19 to July 3, 1981 at the Technological University of the Philippines, Manila Technician Institute, Taguig, Metro Manila

2 The Course is a pioneering effort and envisioned to clarify major issues, establish norms and standards for accreditation, and thresh out problems of implementation. The expected outcome of the course is a proposed organizational structure and operational mechanism for the implementation of a national system of accreditation in technician education.

3 Participants in the course will be senior school officials and managers from industries who are directly engaged in technician education and employment. Inclosed is a list of the participating schools.

4 Considering the importance of the course in upgrading the vocational-technical education program in the country, it is enjoined that school officials involved in the program be encouraged to participate in the course.

5 Expenses incident to attendance in the course are chargeable against local or institutional funds subject to the usual accounting and auditing rules.
