SEMINAR-WORKSHOPS ON THE USE OF MEDIA
FOR NONFORMAL EDUCATION

To: Bureau Directors
Regional Directors
- Chiefs of Services and Heads of Units

1. The Communication Foundation for Asia, in cooperation with the Ministry of Education and Culture, will conduct a series of national level live-in seminar-workshops on the use of media for nonformal education, on the following dates and topics:

- a. May 3-10, 1981 - Low Cost Media Materials
- b. May 17-24, 1981 - Radio Script Writing and Production
- c. July 5-12, 1981 - Low Cost Media Materials
- d. August 2-9, 1981 - Grassroot Theatre

2. The objectives of the seminar-workshops are to:

- a. deepen the participants' concept of development communication through lectures, discussions and interaction with resource persons, CFA staff and other participants;
- b. be aware of one's abilities and potentialities and harness them for the production of functional radio scripts, creative, dramatics and low cost media materials;
- c. engage in worthwhile activities and gain practical knowledge and skills necessary in performing one's role in countryside development;

- d. utilize varied media materials for effective communication with the NFE clientele.
3. Inclosed is the list of expected participants who are selected district NFE Coordinators.
4. Per diems and transportation expenses of participants from their respective stations to Manila and return shall be charged against local funds, subject to the usual accounting and auditing regulations.
5. This is strictly a live-in seminar-workshop. The management will not accept those who will not comply with the rule.
6. Participants are expected to check in at the CFA Training Center, 4437 Int. Old Sta. Mesa, Manila at 3:00 o'clock in the afternoon of May 3 for the first group; May 17 for the second; July 5 for the third and August 2 for the fourth series.
7. It is desired that echo seminar-workshops be conducted in the different regions/divisions as a result of the in-service trainings. A copy of the report on the said trainings should be submitted to the Office of Nonformal Education, MEC, Manila.
8. It is desired that this Memorandum be immediately disseminated.
