ANNOUNCING THE 4TH ANNUAL SEARCH FOR "THE 1981
OUTSTANDING YCAP SERVICE (TOYS) AWARDS"

To: Bureau Directors

1. The Ministry of Education and Culture and the YCAP Foundation of the Philippines, Inc. are jointly sponsoring the 4th Annual Search for "The 1981 Outstanding YCAP Service (TOYS) Awards" with the award ceremonies to be held at the Philamlife Auditorium on May 25, at 5:30 P.M.

2. The objectives of the TOYS Awards are to:

- a. properly acknowledge outstanding YCAP projects and achievements of school administrators, coordinators, student YCAPers and agency action officers;
- b. provide incentives, rewards, and recognition of youth participation in national development;
- c. encourage more support from school administrators, parents, community for the YCAP activities; and
- d. document performance of YCAP for past school years.

3. The search of the 1981 TOYS awards includes the search for the Outstanding YCAP and the Outstanding Male YCAP Student.

4. Deadline for submission of nominees at the National Integrated YCAP Office Secretariat, MEC, Amorsargo Street, Manila from the regional offices shall be on

May 15, 1981. It is understood that regional nominees for the national awards shall be selected by the MEC regional YCAP coordinating committee, the regional YCAP coordinators association, and the YCAP foundation regional chapter awards committee from among the school divisions/districts/schools with outstanding YCAP projects.

5. Selected members of the YCAP inter-agency committee shall serve as the National Awards TOYS Evaluation Team who shall visit the regions to assess the recommendees.

6. This year's award will focus on three major YCAP thrusts, namely: Adopt-a-Barangay for Community Development (ABCD), which shall include ANICARE, EDUCARE, KBSC, and PUSTE under this category; Treeplanting Action Program (TAP) to include Nurseries, seedbanking, and Dendro Thermal; and, Student Tourism/Travel Exchange Program (STEP), which shall include the NYCAS and student organizations. All entries must be supported by photos/pictures and documentary evidences.

7. Inclosed are the general guidelines/criteria for 1981 TOYS Awards.

8. All regional winners must be presented during the awarding ceremony. Their transportation expenses shall be charged against the regional YCAP fund.

9. Immediate dissemination of this Memorandum and the joint efforts of all concerned to ensure the success of the project is hereby enjoined.

CRITERIA FOR 1981 TOYS AWARDS

General Guidelines:

1. In order to ensure validity and reliability of team evaluation of YCAP projects school year 1980-1981 as distinct from other MEC programs and projects, the following set of criteria shall be adopted in the school, district, division, regional and national search for 1981 TOYS Awards.
2. As a general rule, only YCAP accredited projects of school, district, division or regions with at least 50 per cent of the school population with insurance coverage with the Philanggen Insurance Company are qualified to participate in the search.
3. The 1981 TOYS Award shall be limited to the following three (3) major YCAP Program thrusts:

Adopt-a-Barangay for Community Development (ABCD) which shall be based on the holistic and integrated effect of the YCAP Project in the barangay in terms of:

a. <u>Impact</u> - Observable and tangible change on: . . .	Points

b. <u>Involvement or participation</u> (quantity and quality).	40%

c. <u>Innovative Strategies used</u>	20%
(1) Resource identification	<u>10</u>
