- 1. The Korean National Commission for UNESCO is inviting all Filipino children, 6 to 12 years old, to take part in the 23rd World School Children's Art Exhibition under the joint sponsorship of the Korean Children's Center and Korea's Ministry of Culture and Information. The exhibition will be held on September 25, 1981.
- 2. The purpose of this cultural event is to promote mutual understanding, strengthen friendship among the children of the world, and encourage them in art education through exchange of their art works.
- 3. Participants may use oil or water color, crayon, pastel, woodblock, print, collage, etc. in a 55 cm x 40 cm size work. Only one entry should be sent by each participant and at the back of his entry the following information name, age, sex, name of school, title of entry, nationality should be written in English and in capital letters.
- 4. Entries should be sent direct to the Korean Children's Center, San 3-39, Neung-dong, Seongdongku, Seoul 133, Korea, in time to be received there not later than August 15, 1981. They may be in bundles if there are more than one entry from a school.

- 5. Various prizes will be awarded including top superior, gold, silver, bronze medals and certificates of good work and selected work. The prizes will be awarded on September 25, 1934 at the Korean Children's Center. The prizes and certificates will be sent to the schools concerned directly or through diplomatic channels.
- 6. Dissemination of the contents of this Memorandum, particularly at the opening of SY 1981-82, is desired so that as many pupils as are interested can participate in the contest.
