3-DAY SOFTBALL SEMINAR/CLINIC

- 1. The Ministry of Education and Culture and the National Schools Sports Council (MEC-NSSC), will hold a 3-day Softball Seminar/Clinic at the Paglaum Sports Complex, Bacolod City on June 24-26 1381. Inclosed is the Clinic Organizing Committee.

- 4. A registration fee of two hundred seventy pesos (P270) will be charged each delegate to defray cost of materials and other expenses including snacks and meals.

  All expenses incurred relative to attendance in this seminar may be charged against local funds, subject to the usual accounting and auditing regulations.
