3-DAY SOFTBALL SEMINAR/CLINIC

To: Bureau Directors
Regional Directors

1. The Ministry of Education and Culture and the National Schools Sports Council (MEC-NSSC), will hold a 3-day Softball Seminar/Clinic at the Paglaum Sports Complex, Bacolod City on June 24-26 1981. Inclosed is the Clinic Organizing Committee.

2. The theme of the seminar is "Asean Solidarity Through Sports - Softball." After the seminar the participants can:

- a. teach and coach students and athletes effectively;
- b. lead in the correct interpretation of the governing rules and regulations of the games;
- c. improve knowledges, skills, strategies and techniques in softball among students and athletes;
- d. prepare athletes to participate in local, regional, national, or ASEAN softball games with improved athletic and behavioral qualities; and
- e. foster to the optimum level camaraderie among ASEAN youth through softball as a sports.

3. Participants to the seminar will be two delegates each from the five (5) ASEAN Schools Sports Council members namely: Indonesia, Malaysia, Philippines, Thailand, and Singapore. The Philippines, however, being the host country, is allowed to have the following additional delegates: two from each region and one each from private schools, colleges and universities and other agencies with softball sports program.

4. A registration fee of two hundred seventy pesos (P270) will be charged each delegate to defray cost of materials and other expenses including snacks and meals. All expenses incurred relative to attendance in this seminar may be charged against local funds, subject to the usual accounting and auditing regulations.
