ORIENTATION CONFERENCE ON NEW DIRECTIONS  
FOR SECONDARY EDUCATION

To: Regional Directors

1. The Bureau of Secondary Education will hold a three-day orientation conference for the regional chiefs of secondary education at the BSE Conference Hall on June 24-26, 1981, to draw up plans for the implementation of new curriculum outlines prepared by the Curriculum Development Division of this Bureau.
2. The participants will be regional chiefs of secondary education divisions or their duly designated representatives.
3. Specifically, the objectives of the workshop are to:
  - a. demonstrate the use of the new values-oriented curriculum framework;
  - b. define the specific responsibilities of the regional, division and school officials in the reprinting of the materials: the reading tests and the curriculum frameworks, so that all secondary school teachers can be provided with copies of both;
  - c. prepare guidelines for the orientation of secondary school teachers in the use of the new frameworks;
  - d. plan the administration of diagnostic reading tests for incoming first-year students as announced in MEC Memorandum No. 40, s. 1981. This is being postponed to July 15, 1981; and

- e. agree on the use of the test results to plan reading programs for the different schools.
- 4. Travel expenses incident to the attendance and participation in this workshop are chargeable to local funds, subject to the usual accounting and auditing rules and regulations.
- 5. Immediate dissemination of this Memorandum is desired.
