ASSISTANCE TO REMOTE PRIVATE SCHOOLS ON THE USE OF TEACHER TRAINING MODULES IN POPULATION EDUCATION

To: Bureau Directors
Regional Directors
Schools Superintendents
Heads of Private Schools, Colleges and Universities

- 1. The Population Center Foundation in cooperation with the Population Education Center (PEC) of the Ministry of Education and Culture (MEC) has launched a project that will make available to private schools in remote areas modules in Population Education for training their teachers. This project is a direct response to the lack of teacher training materials in population education a problem identified by private school administrators in fully integrating population education in their curricula.
- Copies of said modules may be requested free of charge (including mailing) from the Officer-in-Charge, RU Population Education for Private Schools, Population Center Foundation, South Superhighway, Makati, Metro Manila. The request should include: a) the modules needed and the number of copies of each, and b) a plan of action on how they will be used, with the notation scheme for the limited number of copies that shall be received.
- 3. In view of the project's limited budget, requested copies should not exceed 2 sets of 14 modules for schools with 10 or less number of teachers. Additional copies may be requested subject to the availability of same.
- 4. To be able to effectively use these modules in training their teachers, private school heads may seek assistance from the MEC regional office. Regional office supervisors and supervisory training teams (STTs) in respective school divisions are enjoined to provide the necessary assistance needed by private schools in remote areas in the conduct of this project.

Immediate dissemination of the contents of this orandum to those concerned is desired.
