THE FIFTH COMPETITION OF THE MEC-PHILAMLIFE SCHOLARSHIP
PROGRAM IN GUIDANCE (GRADUATE LEVEL)

To: Bureau Directors
Regional Directors
Schools Superintendents
Presidents, State Colleges and Universities
Heads of Private Schools, Colleges and Universities

1. The fifth phase (1981-1983) of the MEC-Philamlife Scholarship Program in Guidance will commence during the second semester of school year 1981-1982.

2. Accordingly, the various steps/activities of the program are scheduled as follows:

- a. June 26, 1981 - Receipt of application forms and information sheets by the MEC regional offices from the main or regional offices of the Philippine-American Life Insurance Company
- b. July 20, 1981 - Last day for submission of the names and papers of the candidates of their divisions to the regional director by school superintendents
- c. August 3, 1981 - Deadline for the submission of nomination forms and all supporting papers of the five (5) nominees from each region by the regional director to:

- d. August 17 to September 4, 1981 - Testing and interview of candidates by the MEC-UP teams with the regional offices as venues
- e. October 9, 1981 - Final selection of scholars by the MEC-Philamlife-UP Scholarship Committee

f. October 12-23, 1981 - Announcement of scholars, orientation and pre-enrolment activities

g. October 27, 1981 - Registration in the university by the scholars

3. Attention is invited to paragraph 4 of Department Memorandum No. 138, s. 1978, on Guidelines on the Continuing Program on Guidance. Specifically, the paragraph stipulates among other things that candidates for the scholarship should be high school teachers and/or guidance counselors who are not over forty years old. They should have obtained an over-all grade-point average of not less than 2.5 and without any failing grades in the undergraduate level.

4. Attention is likewise invited to paragraph 5-c of the aforementioned Memorandum which enumerates the supporting documents that should accompany each nomination. Further, other scholarship requirements are specified in paragraphs 3 and 4 of MEC Memorandum No. 165, s. 1978.

5. Inclosed is the tentative schedule of testing and interview of the candidates of the various regions.

6. Immediate dissemination of this Memorandum is requested.
