FOURTH FAT PHILIPPINE FOLK FESTIVAL

1. The Folk Arts Theater (FAT) will hold its Fourth Philippine Folk Festival at the Folk Arts Theater, on Roxas Boulevard, Manila on July 5-12, 1981. This festival will be participated in by the provinces all over the country which will present their authentic music and dances. Inclosed is a schedule of activities.
2. A dance workshop for teachers, students and folk dancing enthusiasts will also be held on July 6-9 which aims to reveal the authenticity in folk styles of our Christian and non-Christian brothers; the folkways revealed by their rituals, festivals and other ceremonies; characteristics and beliefs as shown by the rich and diversified Filipino culture through music and dance.
3. A registration fee of two hundred pesos (P200) will be charged each participant in the workshop. This will be from the personal funds of the delegates. A certificate of attendance shall be issued by the Folk Arts Theater Organizing Committee.
4. Considering the benefits that will be derived from this dance festival and workshop, as many teachers and students as are interested should be encouraged to attend them. Attendance of participants from the public school sector, however, shall be on official time only.
5. Immediate and wide dissemination of this Memorandum is desired.
