OFFICIAL RESULTS OF THE SELECTION OF 1981  
AWARDEES UNDER THE SELECTED ETHNIC GROUPS  
EDUCATIONAL ASSISTANCE PROGRAM

To: Bureau Directors  
Regional Directors  
Schools Superintendents  
Presidents, State Colleges and Universities  
Heads of Private Schools, Colleges and Universities

1. Inclosed are two lists containing the names of thirty-two (32) members of non-Muslim cultural communities who qualified in the Selected Ethnic Groups Educational Assistance Test, secondary level; and fifty-eight (58), in the collegiate level, given on January 25, 1981 per MEC Memorandum No. 164, s. 1980.
2. These qualifiers whose study grant takes effect on the first semester, school year 1981-1982, shall be financially supported in their high school and university studies.
3. The release of thirteen (13) names in the secondary and fourteen (14) in the collegiate level is still withheld pending submission and verification of some required documents.
4. All awardees are requested to advise the National Scholarship Center, this Ministry, the soonest possible time of their acceptance or rejection of the grant upon receipt of the Notice of Award or information on their having qualified.
5. In case of acceptance, the new grantee shall specify the course he is encouraged to take and the school he will enrol in.
6. Awardees who come from the two autonomous regions (Regions IX and XII) should be advised to study in schools, preferably state colleges and universities, within their home regions. They should obtain their enrolment letter and other documents from their respective Regional Office Scholarship Units (ROSU). However, if they intend to study outside the autonomous regions, they should secure prior approval from the ROSU concerned.

7. All high schools, colleges and universities where these study grantees will enrol are requested to submit to the Center or ROSU, without delay, their Confirmation of Subjects enrolled in an Itemized Statement of Accounts to facilitate payment of their stipends and school fees.

8. Immediate dissemination of the contents of this Memorandum to those concerned is hereby enjoined.
