1981 ALAY TANIM CONTESTS

To: Bureau Directors
Regional Directors
Schools Superintendents
Chiefs of Services and Heads of Units
Vocational Schools Superintendents/Administrators

1. The Sixth National Alay Tanim Contests will be conducted from June 22, 1981 to March 31, 1982.
2. The contests this school year highlight Phase VI of the implementation of LOI Nos. 585 and 872(6), the Alay Tanim Programs; LOI No. 764, the School Health Guardian Program and LOI No. 1023, Community Projects/Services. Phase VI seeks to further strengthen in all the school divisions the implementation and integration of all programs/projects of the School Health and Nutrition Center (SHNC), namely: Alay Tanim-Orchard Development and Food Production; Nutrition Education/Supplementary Feeding; Health Services; Environmental Sanitation; and the School Health Guardian Program with emphasis on studies on the uses of medicinal plants; as well as LOI No. 1023, Community Projects/Services. Private schools may be included in the contests.
3. The contests should start among schools within the district, among districts within the division and finally, among divisions within the region. All superintendents should submit to the SHNC, MEC Manila the list of the best ten (10) schools per division and the regional director for the best ten (10) schools per region.
4. Entries should be submitted on or before September 1 to the Chairman, National Evaluation Committee, MEC, Manila, Attention: Assistant Secretary Vedasto G. Suarez. Evaluation of regional entries will start on September 11, to enable this Office to make the announcement of regional and national winners on December 1.

5. A Bagong Lipunan school building will be awarded to each school division that qualifies as the regional winner receiving the highest points in the implementation of LOI No. 586, LOI No. 764 and the other programs/projects of SHNC. Regional winners in the contest on the implementation of LOI No. 872(6) or the School Health Guardian Program in National Agricultural Schools will likewise receive a Bagong Lipunan school building. It is therefore requested that each region select three (3) divisions and an agricultural school as entries for the best implementor of these integrated SHNC programs/projects. The national winners - a school division each for Luzon, Visayas and Mindanao - will likewise receive their national prize: a Bagong Lipunan school building.

6. Divisions that will have won the national prize for three (3) consecutive years shall be awarded a National trophy for outstanding accomplishment in the implementation of the Integrated School Health Guardian Programs and Projects in addition to the regular prize - the school building. For as long as the said division maintains the quality of the implementation of the SHNC programs and projects, it will continue to receive a national Certificate of Recognition award, but it will no longer receive a building as a prize. This will give other divisions a chance to win a national prize.

7. The guidelines for the implementation of LOI Nos. 586, 764 and 872(6) which should be used as bases for the selection of regional and national winners are inclosed.

8. Likewise, inclosed for ready reference is the list of names of evaluation teams officials.

9. Immediate dissemination of this Memorandum is desired.
