NATIONAL SCHOLARSHIP AND STUDY GRANT EXAMINATIONS
FOR SCHOOL YEAR 1982-1983

To: Bureau Directors
Regional Directors
Chiefs of Services and Heads of Units

Heads of Private Schools, Colleges and Universities

1. The national examinations for scholarship under the State Scholarship, National Integration Study Grant, Selected Ethnic Groups Educational Assistance, Presidential Memorandum Order (PMO) No. 697 Work-Study Grant for Southern Philippines, Kabataang Barangay Scholarship and Teijin Limited Scholarship Programs for school year 1982-1983 will be jointly administered by the National Scholarship Center and the National Educational Testing Center, this Ministry, on December 12, 1981.

2. The timetable for screening and other activities for these examinations are as follows:

a. Screening

Publicity period July 16 to Sept. 15

Start of screening and selection of
qualified applicants by High School

Screening Committee July 16 to Sept. 15

Submission by the High School Screen-
ing Committee to the Division Screen-
ing Committee of the list of quali-
fied applicants, together with the
accomplished application forms and
supporting documents Sept. 16 to Oct. 15

Submission by the Division Screening
Committee of the consolidated list
of qualified applicants, using the
forms under Inclosure 3, 4 and 5, to
the National Scholarship Center, copy
furnished the Regional Office. (Sup-
porting documents shall be handed to
the examiner during the examinations) Oct. 16 to Nov. 15

b. Administration

Collegiate December 12
(8:00 a.m.-12:00 noon)

Secondary December 12
(2:00-4:00 p.m.)

3. The set of guidelines on the selection of qualified applicants and other pertinent matters are inclosed for strict compliance by those concerned.
4. An applicant may apply for a grant under more than one program if he/she qualifies; however, the NSC, in this particular case, reserves the right to select the program most suitable for the applicant.
5. An examination fee of three pesos (₱3.00) shall be charged every qualified applicant who shall be issued a copy of the application form. (See sample copy, Inclosure 2)
6. The examination fees paid by the qualified applicants shall be forwarded by the division office to the National Scholarship Center in cash or in postal money order on or before December 1, 1981, together with the list of qualified applicants.
7. Specifically, the examinations for the State Scholarship Program (SSP), the National Integration Study Grant Program (NISGP), the Selected Ethnic Groups Educational Assistance Program (SEGEAP), the Kabataang Barangay Scholarship Program (KBSP) and the Teijin Limited Scholarship Program (TLSP) shall be conducted nationwide in the same test centers that were utilized in the last scholarship/study grant examinations.
8. Applicants under PMO 697 Work-Study Grant Program for Southern Philippines will take the state scholarship or study grant examination in any of the test centers in Regions IX and XII.
9. Examiners from the Central Office will administer the test. They will also brief test proctors and coordinators at least a day before the examination.
10. Applicants must bring a No. 1 lead pencil and their test permits during the examination day.
11. To forestall any complaint or disqualification of any applicant, the screening committees are urged to strictly follow the guidelines set, particularly the income requirement of the applicant's parents, the applicant's tribe membership, and the verification of authenticity of amnesty papers or certification that one is a rebel-returnee.

12. It is desired that those concerned cooperate in the dissemination of this information.

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GUIDELINES ON THE SELECTION OF
QUALIFIED APPLICANTS

A. As to Qualifications

1. For the State Scholarship Program

- (a) He must be among the first ten of the graduating class in which he is enrolled as regular fourth year student at the time the scholarship test is given, as certified to by the high school principal;
- (b) He shall be considered "poor" which means that the gross income of his parents or if already dead, the court-appointed guardian is not in excess of ₱12,000.00 per annum, as evidenced by a certified true copy of the 1980 BIR Income Tax Return;
- (c) He must be in good health, of excellent moral character and unquestionable integrity, as certified to by the principal of the high school; and
- (d) He must be a natural-born citizen of the Philippines and shall not be more than 21 years of age at the time of his selection.

2. For the National Integration Study Grant and the Selected Ethnic Groups Educational Assistance Programs

- (a) He must be a bonafide member of any of the national Cultural communities, as certified to by the PANAMIN Head Office; or PANAMIN Regional Director;
- (b) His parents' or if already dead, the court-appointed guardians' annual gross income is not in excess of ₱12,000.00 as determined by a certified true copy of the 1980 BIR Income Tax Return;
- (c) He must be graduating from high school during the school year 1981-1982 and must

belong to the upper 15 percent of the graduating class excluding students from the non-cultural communities, as certified to by the high school principal;

- (d) He must be physically fit and of good moral character per certification of the high school principal; and
- (e) He must not be over 25 years old at the time of his selection as a grantee.

3. For the Selected Ethnic Groups Educational Assistance Program (elementary graduates)

- (a) He must belong to any of the following "hill" tribes as certified to by the PANAMIN Head Office or PANAMIN Regional Director:

Agta, Agta-Abiyan, Agutaynon, Alangan, Ata-Matigsalog, Bolinao, Buid Batangan/Buid Bangan, Banton, B'laan, Kapul, Haruno, Ikalahan, Iraya, Kalibugan, Kulaman, Mansaka, Palawan/Pinalawan, Tagaydan, Tagbanua, Tagabili/T'boli, Tagacaolo, and Tiruray;

- (b) He must meet the qualification (b) of 2 above, and
- (c) He must belong to the top 5 per cent of the graduating elementary class, non-cultural community students excluded.

4. For the qualifying examination under PMO No. 697 Work-Study Grant Program for Southern Philippines (Regions IX and XII)

- (a) He must be a returnee or rejoiner (A returnee is one who has surrendered and renounced his ties with the rebel group and returned to the folds of the law. A rejoiner is a rebel who volunteers to help the government without severing his ties with his rebel organization.)
- (b) If the returnee/rejoiner is not in a capacity to accept the grant he can waive it in favor of any one of the following: the wife, son/daughter, brother/sister, at the option of the grantee, and
- (c) He must be either graduating or have graduated in the elementary or high school or have earned units in college.

5. For the KB Scholarship Program

- (a) He must be a member of good standing in the KB organization as proven by his current, updated KB identification membership card;
- (b) He must be certified to by the PKKB Regional Youth Development Director as possessing excellent leadership potentials;
- (c) He must be financially handicapped to pursue a post-secondary course, considering the annual gross income of his parents or if already dead court-appointed guardian; which should not be in excess of ₱12,000.00; and
- (d) He must be above-average intelligence belonging to the upper 15 per cent of the graduating class.

6. For the Teijin Scholarship Program

- (a) He must be a Filipino Citizen;
- (b) He must be not more than 21 years of age at the time of his selection as a scholar;
- (c) He must be graduating from high school or a high school graduate whose average rating is 80 per cent or better provided, he has not earned any unit or credit in any post-secondary course;
- (d) He must be of good health, excellent moral character, and unquestionable integrity;
- (e) He must be single;
- (f) He must pass the interview after the test; and
- (g) He must pursue any of the courses, namely: BS Chemistry, Chemical Engineering, Textile Chemistry, Mechanical Engineering, Industrial Engineering, B.S. Statistics, Management Engineering and other allied courses

C. As to Documents Required:

1. For SSP, NISGP, and SEGEAP Applicants

- (a) Certified true copy of the 1980 BIR Income Tax Return of applicant's parents or if already dead, the court-appointed guardian (To be attached to the application form which should be duly accomplished and signed by all concerned and submitted to the National Scholarship Center through the examiner during the administration of the test);
- (b) Certification of tribe membership in cultural community by PANAMIN Head Office or PANAMIN Regional Director, in case of non-Muslim and by Governor, Mayor, school principal, barangay captain or other responsible officials in cultural communities who are in the best position to certify tribe-membership, in case of Muslim ethnic group. (applicable only to NISGP and SEGEAP applicants);
- (c) Scholastic records in high school with photograph attached;
- (d) Certificate of good moral character issued by Barangay Captain or School Principal;
- (e) Certification by the Principal that applicant belongs to the top ten of the high school graduating class (only for SST applicants);
- (f) Certification by the High School Principal that the applicant belongs to the upper 15 per cent of the graduating class, excluding non-cultural community members; (for NISGP and SEGEAP (collegiate) applicants);
- (g) Certification by the Elementary School Principal that the applicant belongs to the top 5 per cent of the graduating elementary class, non-cultural community students excluded. (Only for SEGEAP (secondary) applicants).

2. For PMO 697 Work Study Grant Program Applicants

- (a) Original and authentic certification from the appropriate Military Commander of his authorized representative that he is a returnee/rejoinee. Certified true copy of amnesty papers may be accepted provided original is shown to Provincial or Sub-Regional Processing officer;
- (b) One (1) 2" X 2" ID picture with his official signature signed across it and with his right and left thumb marks affixed at the back of the picture to be attached to the test permit and one (1) picture of the candidate together with his former Commander to be attached to the application form;
- (c) In the case of the next of kin of returnee/rejoinee, two (2) sets of 2" X 2" ID picture of applicant together with the returnee/rejoinee. In addition, an affidavit duly executed before a judge, mayor or notary public by the returnee/rejoinee himself indicating his relationship to the next-of-kin and his desire to have said relative enjoy the privilege in as much as for some valid reason (s) he could not avail of the opportunity;
- (d) Report Card (Form 135) for the last curriculum year enrolled in, for applicants in the high school, and Report Card (Form 138) for the fourth year or transcript of records for those applying for college degree program or in lieu thereof, present such proofs or records which are satisfactory to the Screening Committee.

3. For applicants to the KB Scholarship Program

- (a) Copy of his identification card or its equivalent as a KB member or a reproduction thereof;
- (b) Certification from the PKK8 Regional Youth Development Director that the applicant possesses excellent potential of a community leader;

- (c) 1980 BIR Income Tax Return of his parents or if already dead, the ITR of the court-appointed guardian of the previous year proving that the gross annual income is not in excess of ₱12,000.00;
- (d) Form 138 for high school students or transcript of records reflecting all the subjects completed and units earned for those who are in post-secondary courses;
- (e) Certification by the Principal, that he/she belongs to the upper 15 per cent of the graduating class;
- (f) National College Entrance Examination (NCEE) rating or a certified reproduction thereof;
- (g) Student Descriptive Questionnaire (Available at the Office of the PKKB Regional Youth Development Director).

4. For Teijin Limited Scholarship Program Applicants

- (a) Health certificate issued by a government physician;
- (b) Permanent record or report card (Form 137-B) in the high school with identification picture;
- (c) Certification of good moral character signed by the secondary school principal.

5. Other Matters

Only one returnee/rejoiner or next -of-kin, per family shall be entitled to a study grant at any given time. The grantee shall enroll preferably in a state college or university located in his province or region, unless the course he desires to pursue is not offered in said state college or university, in which case he may enroll in any authorized private college or university also within his province or region.
