OBJECTIVE

The Wildlife Society of the Philippines (WISPHIL) in cooperation with the National Environmental Protection Council (NEPC), Ministry of Human Settlements is sponsoring the NATIONAL ENVIRONMENTAL POSTER CONTEST 1981.

This contest is designed to promote environmental consciousness among the Filipino people.

This activity is also a gesture of support to the 10th Anniversary celebration of the United Nations Conference on the Human Environment held in Stockholm in 1972. It is also a prelude to the bigger activity - the INTERNATIONAL POSTER CONTEST 1982 sponsored by the Environment Liaison Centre (ELC) scheduled to be held in Nairobi, Kenya next March.

MECHANICS OF IMPLEMENTATION

The WISPHIL shall adopt the guidelines, rules and regulations defined by ELC. However, the WISPHIL shall also adopt some rules and regulations fitted for the local selections.

CATEGORIES

a) children up to 12 years old b) persons over 12 years old

THEME

Only One Earth This is our environment. What relationship have we established with it? What have we done for and with it? What has to be done in the years to come?

TEXT

The posters shall carry any of the following slogans:

- a) Protect the environment.
- b) Let us uphold our right to a healthy environment.
-) Fight pollution.
- d) The environment is our source of life and wealth. Protect it.
- e) A healthy environment means you don't have to go far for fresh air and clean water.

The artist may create his own slogan provided it is related to the theme and the above slogans.

The following phrase has to be included in every poster:

5 June 1982. Ten Years after Stockholm.

TECHNICAL ASPECTS

Type of paper - the posters should be prepared on a clean cartolina, bristol, illustration or similar board.

The size should be 18×24 inches.

DEADLINE

All entries must be submitted on or before 31 October 1981.

If entries are mailed, it must be post-marked not later than the above-mentioned date.

SELECTION PROCESS

A panel of carefully selected judges shall make the selection on 31 October 1981 at the lobby of the Quezon City Civic Center where the posters will be displayed.

The date and place of the Awarding Ceremonies will be announced later.

The three best entries will be sent to the ELC in Nairobi, Kenya as entries in the International Poster Contest 1982.
