SEARCH FOR THE TEN OUTSTANDING YOUTH LEADERS
IN THE PHILIPPINES

To: Bureau Directors
Regional Directors
Schools Superintendents
Presidents, State Colleges and Universities
Heads of Private Schools, Colleges and Universities

1. The youth has been and always will be a potent indispensable resource of the country. Drawing the youth leaders together and recognizing their capabilities will bring about formidable and beneficial results.
2. Towards this end, the Philippine Association of Youth Leaders, Inc., (PAYLI), which aims to draw together youth leaders all over the country by providing a setting for mutual friendship, understanding and cooperation, announces the Search for Ten Outstanding Youth Leaders in the Philippines.
3. To ensure quality and fairness, the following will be considered as bases for the selection:
 - a. He/She must be a college student. (Each college or university, public or private, will have only one (1) candidate/representative).
 - b. Personal bio-data.
 - c. Active involvement in both academic and extra-curricular activities to be attested by the Dean for Student Affairs.
 - d. Active involvement in community affairs to be attested by the Barangay Captain and/or the local government executive.
 - e. Certificate of good moral character duly signed by the Dean for Student Affairs.

f. An essay written in 300 words (minimum) or 500 words (maximum) on the topic: "The Role of Filipino Student Leaders as Future Inheritors of This Country."

g. Interview sessions.

4. The following should therefore be submitted on or before August 20, 1981 to Deputy Minister of Education and Culture FELICITA G. BERNARDINO, Chairman of the 1981 Search for Ten Outstanding Youth Leaders, c/o Office of Nonformal Education, MEC, Manila, Tel. Nos. 40-41-48, 49-24-96 or 49-65-87:

a. Certificate of Enrollment duly signed by the Registrar of the College/University.

b. Personal bio-data.

c. Certificate of active involvement in both academic and extracurricular activities.

d. Certificate of active involvement in community affairs.

e. Essay on: "The Role of Filipino Student Leaders as Future Inheritors of this Country." The manuscript should be typewritten double-spaced on legal size bond paper and certified by the principal/director/head teacher of the school, as the case may be, that it is the original work of the author.

5. The Chairman of the Board of Trustees, Hon. Nancy Q. Sison or Mr. Domingo V. Agda, National Coordinator, shall further notify all qualified nominees through telegram by the end of August.

6. The awarding ceremonies which coincide with PAYLI's Sixth Founding Anniversary will be held on September 15, 1981.

7. Immediate dissemination of the contents of this Memorandum in all colleges and universities is desired.
